Mechanistic Organic Chemistry, Department of Chemistry, Faculty of Science, Hokkaido University

### **3. Research Field**

Organic chemistry and related research areas. A researcher who can actively work, with Prof. Aiichiro Nagaki, on interdisciplinary research involving flow chemistry, chemical biology, material science, data science, and others for super-fast creation of functional compounds.

### **4. Qualifications**

The successful candidate should have a Ph.D. degree, or be projected to have a Ph.D. by the starting date.

(4) Outline of the applicant's research to date (about 1500 words, excluding words in the figures from the word limit) and aspirations for future research plans and education (about 1000 words and 500 words, respectively) (2 copies each)

(5) Recommendation letters, or name and contact information of your referees who are familiar with the applicant's personality and research (from 2 individuals)

(6) Other research activities (awards, international conference presentations [divided into invited lectures, oral presentations, and poster presentations], domestic conference presentations [divided into invited lectures, oral presentations, and poster presentations], external research funding, outreach activities, study abroad experience, etc.) (2 copies)
